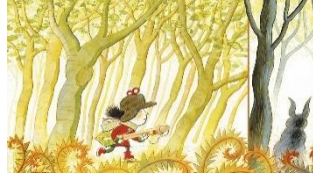


Year 1 Homework

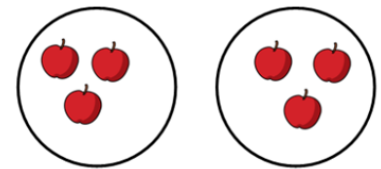


Dear Parents and Carers,

In English, the children have continued their learning linked to the text 'The Last Wolf' by Mini Grey. This week, the children explored the key features of a different hunting narrative such as: sentence openers; alliteration; adjectives; use of 'and' as a conjunction; question sentences and sentences exclamation sentences to show strong emotion. The children used this learning to start the beginning of their 'plan' ready to begin their own version of a hunting narrative. They will be encouraged to use some of the key features from the example text in their own stories. Such features include: sentence openers, alliteration, adjectives, use of 'and' as a conjunction as well as in a list, questions and sentences punctuated with exclamation marks to show strong emotion. Also, the children have written a character description of Little Red who is a character from the story book 'The Last Wolf.'

In Maths, we have begun our learning about fractions and this week we have been focussing on finding a half of a shape, object or quantity. The children have had the opportunity to use concrete manipulatives to practise finding half by sharing objects equally. Through our practise of this skill we have taught the children to represent their calculations pictorially using an image where the objects can be drawn one by one into two circles to be shared equally. Please find an example of this to the right.
