Golden Rules/Behaviour

Sometimes our children, because they are young, forget the Golden Rules (Be Kind, Be Safe and Work Hard). If we know that these rules have been broken, then we will always take the time to find out what has happened and help the child who has made the wrong choice reflect on their behaviour. There may also be a sanction put in place if the inappropriate behaviour continues. We encourage our children wherever possible to solve their "fall outs" by using their words and talking things through. It is also important to remember that some children maybe experiencing difficulties in school because of something that is happening in their life at the time. However, if you are concerned about something that has happened in school or the behaviour of another child then the best course of action is to speak directly to your child's class teacher. They will be able to sort out the problem quickly to make sure that the risk of it happening again is minimised.

Trophies

In our weekly celebration assembly we give out trophies to children. Unfortunately, many of our trophies have not been returned and we are now missing some. I would be grateful if you could check at home whether you have any of our trophies and return them to school as soon as possible so other children can experience the delight of receiving one.

Bikes and Scooters

We encourage our children to walk, cycle and scoot to school. However, once in the school grounds, we ask that children refrain from cycling or scooting in the playground as there are too many people to manoeuvre around safely. Bikes and scooters may be stored in the cycle rack at the top of the playground but I would advise you to lock them up.

Annexe Rental

Our annexe is currently used for our before and after school club. This operates Monday to Friday from 7.15-9.30am and 2.30-5.45pm. The building is, however, available for hire between these times. Attendance
