ACTIVITIES

Reading – Read your Bug Club active learn book and your own Reading for Pleasure book.

Maths – Visit the website below and play the “Coins Game”. Begin by sorting the coins to practise the identification of the coins that the children have been learning about this week. After you could practise ordering the coins from the lowest to the greatest value and then use the counting heading to practise counting the coins and finding the value of the coins. There are a number of different activities within each of the three sections to practise and they vary in difficulty so you can gauge how your child is responding to the challenges and adjust the difficulty so they are adequately challenged.
