Dear Parents and Carers,

In English, the children have finished writing our narrative stories. Many children have included fabulous sentences and worked very independently showing their mastery of full stops, capital letters, questions, sentences punctuated with an exclamation mark and their use of 'and' as a conjunction.

In Maths, the children have been learning about numbers to 100. They have practised counting to 100 in 10s playing various games in the classroom with partners. Additionally, they have been practising lots of counting forwards and backwards from any number between 0 and 100. The children have found counting backwards and crossing ten more challenging so we have paid particular attention to that. They have also partitioned numbers into tens and ones. They have also spent time understanding the value of each digit within a number and solving many tricky challenges and developing our problem solving skills.

In Art and Design, the children have completed their wonderful drawings of the Liverpool skyline in the style of pop artist James Rizzi. They look amazing! The children have taken a copy of their artwork home to show you.

In History, Moon Zoom (space exploration) and in science, Materials, the children have completed end of unit quizzes.
